

LIMITED WARRANTY TERMS OF ALPO PRO BOATS OY

Read through these Warranty terms and the owner's handbook or manual of any product prior to using it for the first time.

Boats manufactured by Alpo Pro Boats Oy ("Manufacturer"), herein ("Boats") are granted a limited Warranty ("Warranty") by the Manufacturer according to the following terms and conditions.

The Manufacturer hereby certifies that the Boats are free from materials and manufacturing faults during the period for which the Warranty applies and warrants the functionality and quality of the Boat as the owner may ordinarily expect according to the limitations laid down in this Warranty commitment.

The Warranty period begins when the Boat is delivered to the first owner, or if the Boat has been used for demonstration or other activities from the date of first use and is valid for

- 60 months or 200 running hours of the factory installed engine, whichever expires first when used for recreation.
- 24 months or 300 running hours of the factory installed engine, whichever expires first when used for professional use such as commercial purposes or public transport, including, but not limited to, industrial and commercial activity, public authority, income generating operations, passenger traffic, transport of goods, services within the public sector or rentals, including charter.

The delivery date noted on the handover certificate of the Boat together with all other relevant information such as the hull identification number and serial numbers of the engine and other boat particulars is the effective date of the validity of the Warranty.

All components or products used for repair or replacement according to Warranty are covered for the remaining time for which the limited product Warranty is valid for the product repaired or replaced by said component or product.

International coverage of the Warranty

The Warranty is valid in all countries where the Manufacturer is present either by an appointed boat dealer ("Dealer") or by its own presence at the date of the beginning of the Warranty. This Warranty does not apply in countries where the Manufacturer is not represented as stated on the website of the Manufacturer from time to time.

Warranty coverage

This Warranty covers the hull of the boat, any parts built by the Manufacturer and all manufacturing and installation work executed by the Manufacturer. Any third party equipment such as engines, parts and accessories and equipment sold and installed by the Manufacturer are subject to the Warranty, if any, and their terms provided by the manufacturers of such products. The owner of the boat is responsible for Warranty-registering any such products if such registration is required for the validity of the Warranty.

Equipment acquired and/or installed from other sources than the Manufacturer are not covered by this Warranty.

Responsibility of the Manufacturer

The sole responsibility of the Manufacturer shall be to repair or replace defective products, the option being decided solely by the Manufacturer. With a defective product covered by this limited Warranty is meant a product that has a built-in defect, which existed at the time of delivery from the Manufacturer.

The obligation to perform the Warranty service including necessary parts and delivery of parts are the sole remedy obligation of the Manufacturer under the Warranty.

The repair shall be carried out in a workshop designated by the Manufacturer. If the defect that appears in Boat is not covered by the Warranty, the Manufacturer has the right to charge the owner for any costs that arise from repairing the defect and any possible expenses that occur due to transporting the Boat and the need for personnel to travel. The Manufacturer also has the right to recover expenses that arise for checking the defect and other related costs should the owner's complaint be unsubstantiated.

The Manufacturer is not responsible for indirect, consequential or incidental damages arising from the defect.

For clarity, nothing in these Warranty terms shall exclude or limit Customer's rights that cannot be excluded or limited under applicable law.

What the Warranty does not cover

This Warranty does not cover defects caused by the following:

- Abnormal or incorrect usage or usage against the owner's manual or corresponding document of the relevant product
- Carelessness or negligence
- Competition or preparation for competition
- Use in more demanding conditions than provided by its design category or design norms
- Excessive strain
- Cavitation
- Coloration from UV-radiation
- Oxidation
- Bleaching, coloring or melting due to the use of solvent or chemicals
- Normal wear and tear
- Corrosion
- Incorrect electrical connections such as ungrounded shore-power
- Usage of inferior quality parts
- Lack of or incorrect maintenance

- Unauthorized repairs
- Accidents
- Natural phenomena such as extreme heat, lightning, thunder storm, flooding, war, revolt, terrorist activity or other force majeure
- Incorrect storage or mooring
- Tear and wear caused by conditions outside the Manufacturers control such as ground power leaks
- Failure to follow the owner's manual or similar document, maintenance instructions, assembly instructions or other pertinent instructions provided by the Manufacturer or any third-party supplier of parts, accessories or equipment installed in the boat.
- Alterations, removal or modification of a product or parts, including alteration or modification of software or electrical equipment
- Breaking of seals
- Illegal usage or usage for which the product is not designed
- Boats redeemed by insurance companies
- Changes to Boats external surfaces brought about by weather variations and that have no influence on the strength and serviceability of the Boat or slight irregularities in paint work, lacquer work, woodwork, canopy or chrome finish or other minor surface blemishes
- Mooring equipment
- The Boat has been equipped with a more powerful engine than allowed in the CE plate
- This Warranty does not cover faults caused by the Boats' combination of engines, transmissions or other mechanical or electrical products or accessories that have not been sold or approved in writing by the Manufacturer

The Warranty does not cover mooring equipment, antifouling paint (or similar), liquids, filters, bulbs, fuses, extinguishers, batteries or wipers.

The Boat may be equipped with country-specific elements and features. If a boat has been imported to another country from its original target country, such elements and/or features are not considered as defects covered by this Warranty.

Claims made under the Warranty

Any Warranty claim must be made to the Manufacturer in writing no later than fourteen (14) days from when the defect should have been noticed. It is recommended to ensure proof of which date the report was made, e.g. by means of a copy of the letter to be able to confirm the viability of the Warranty by means of the necessary documentation.

To retain the Warranty, all defects, including but not limited to those related to the safety and seaworthiness of the Boat must be repaired immediately after becoming aware of the defect or from the time it should have been detected. The Warranty will not be retained if the responsibility to report a fault is neglected.
